Sometimes in life we come across situations when we feel the obstacles ahead of us and no solution is in sight. But then if we receive guidance or a helping hand we climb to unexpected positions.

A Thought a Vision of helping hands created - **Volleyball Centre Tikri Kalan** - it brought smiles on the faces of all involved alongwith immense satisfaction. Unguided young children indulging in negative activities (like drugs, petty acts, etc.) are transformed into NATIONAL CHAMPIONS by Founder & Coach: **Sunil Kumar** (Former National Level Volleyball Player in association with ISDC & Foundation JPS Director Sh. J.P Singh Sahni & others) Location: Tikri Kalan, Delhi, Established: 2017 Only Centre in Delhi providing "completely free volleyball coaching" for girls My name is **Sunil Kumar**, Volleyball Coach and founder of Volleyball Centre Tikri Kalan. I want to share with you how I started my Volleyball Centre.

This all started when in 2017, a volleyball tournament was organized in Tikri Kalan by DESU. I went to see the tournament , Boys and girls from our village participated, but their performance was very poor. Since I had played volleyball at the national level, I felt very disappointed. That day I decided to train the boys and girls of my village and make them good players.



In 2017 Sh. J. P. Singh Sahni of Director Foundation JPS and Indian Skills Development Council met me in relation to some work at my village. As he was waiting for me he witnessed some young boys talking about drugs and interacting with a negative language they were using in the dialogue and it was not conducive of progressive children at that point of life Me and **Sh. J.P. Singh Sahni** discussed how to inculcate positivity in their minds so that these youngsters do something meaningful and make their parents and society proud of them and further take part in nation's development.

Since then I have been discussing it with **Sh. J.P. Singh Sahni** on almost every programme and he would like to inform how an idea discussed with in a positive manner by me with a visionary like **Sh. JP Singh Sahni** and his thought got catapulted into a running project that brought accolades and fresh smiles on the faces of the participating youngsters (boys & girls), their families, their teachers, and their friends.



Then I made 2 volleyball grounds there with the help of some young boys and started free evening coaching for girls of our village. I had to face many difficulties there, such as: lack of volleyballs, no referee stand, shortage of other volleyball-related equipment. We did not have these things, so with my own money, I bought the required items.

**To keep children stress-free, i also organized trips:**

**1. \*\*Barot Valley (Himachal Pradesh):\*\***

We rented a traveller bus for ₹8000/day and took 15 children. We cooked food ourselves and managed everything. This was a 5-day trip. I bore all the expenses for this trip.





## 2. **\*\*Kedarnath and Badrinath:\*\***

An 11-day trip, supported by **Sh. J.P. Singh Sahni Ji**, who sponsored Rs.50,000/- for Bus fare. We rented a bus for Rs.9000/- per day. We made our own food and Children enjoyed a lot and stayed in good hotels. At Mana village (last village of India near China border), we even played volleyball at ITBP's volleyball ground after their permission.

**Sh. J.P. Singh Sahni Ji** also supported us by organizing a sports event at our Volleyball Centre on Independence Day (15th August). Players received gifts and prizes, hoisted the flag. Sh J.P Singh ji bore all the expenses of that tournament, we express our heartfelt gratitude to him

डॉ. अनीता गुप्ता एडवोकेट\* की कहानी वास्तव में प्रेरणादायक है। वह भारतीय जनता पार्टी, शाहदरा जिला दिव्यांग प्रकोष्ठ की संयोजक हैं और उनकी जीवन-यात्रा चुनौतियों से भरी रही है। डॉ. अनीता गुप्ता ने अपने जीवन में अनेक कठिनाइयों का सामना किया है, लेकिन उन्होंने कभी हार नहीं मानी।



उत्तर प्रदेश के अलीगढ़ जैसे छोटे शहर में जन्म लेने के बाद, वह अलीगढ़ की पहली लड़की थीं, जो 1992 से स्कूटर और मोटरसाइकिल चलाती थीं। एक दिन, एक ट्रक वाले ने अचानक ब्रेक मारकर ऐसा भयानक एक्सीडेंट कर दिया कि उनका पूरा मुंह और दांत टूट गए। ऐसा लगा जैसे चेहरा दिखाने लायक नहीं रहेगा, लेकिन भगवान की कृपा से ज़िंदगी फिर से पटरी पर आई।

1988 में मकान बनाने के दौरान, छत से बिजली के नंगे तारों को पकड़ते हुए वह सड़क पर गिर गईं, जहाँ पत्थर के टुकड़े पड़े थे। इस हादसे में उनकी पेल्विक बोन की हड्डी टूट गई। मां ने तीन महीने तक बिस्तर पर ही उनकी सेवा की—यूरिन, लैट्रिन कराना और नहलाना—क्योंकि उस स्थान पर प्लास्टर नहीं लगाया जा सकता था और वह न तो हिल सकती थीं, न ही करवट ले सकती थीं।

1990 में सर्दी की एक दवाई ने ऐसा रिएक्शन किया कि पूरे शरीर पर काले धब्बे स्थायी रूप से बन गए। यह समय घरवालों के लिए अत्यंत कठिन था। शादी से पहले शरीर पर स्थायी दाग आ गए थे। उन्होंने आत्महत्या का भी प्रयास किया, लेकिन भगवान की परीक्षा चलती रही।

1992 में शादी के बाद घरेलू हिंसा (डोमेस्टिक वायलेंस) की शिकायत थाने में दर्ज हुई। उन्होंने जीवन को भगवान के हवाले कर दिया।

2005 में एक ओवरलोडेड बस उनके उल्टे हाथ और पैर के ऊपर से गुजर गई। सड़क पर उनका मांस और नसें कटकर बिखर गई थीं। यह देख पब्लिक भी घबरा गई। ICU में उन्हें अनुभव हुआ कि उनकी आत्मा परमात्मा के पास पहुँच चुकी है—बहुत तेज़ रोशनी और एक सुरंग दिखी, जिसमें आत्मा पृथ्वी पर वापस आने का संघर्ष कर रही थी। काफी संघर्ष के बाद आत्मा शरीर में लौटी और फटवरी के महीने में पूरा शरीर पसीने से लथपथ हो चुका था। जब आँखें खुलीं, तब पता चला कि वह पृथ्वी पर वापस हैं।

पहले ऑपरेशन के बाद डॉक्टर ने बताया कि अब उनका उल्टा हाथ और पैर काम नहीं कर पाएंगे, क्योंकि सभी नसें और मांसपेशियाँ कट चुकी थीं। जान बचाने के लिए जो बची-खुची नसें थीं, उन्हें भी निकालना पड़ा। उन्होंने माता रानी का ध्यान किया और कहा, “डॉक्टर और साइंस से ऊपर भी एक शक्ति है।” जहाँ मेडिकल साइंस खत्म होती है, वहाँ भगवान की कृपा शुरू होती है। कई वर्षों तक अनगिनत ऑपरेशनों के बाद भगवान ने उनका हाथ थाम ही लिया।

कुछ ऑपरेशन ऐसे थे जो एक बार में संभव नहीं थे। कई बार ऑपरेशन गलत हुए। कुछ हड्डियाँ तार डालने के बाद भी नहीं जुड़ीं, क्योंकि बहुत समय बीत चुका था और हड्डियों के जुड़ने की संभावना समाप्त हो चुकी थी। ऐसे में दोबारा ऑपरेशन करके हड्डियों का चूरा बनाकर बीच में लगाया गया और नट-बोल्ट से उसे कसा गया, ताकि हड्डी जुड़े या न जुड़े, लेकिन नट-बोल्ट से हड्डी अपनी जगह बनी रहे।

कई ऑपरेशन लगातार नहीं हो सकते थे, क्योंकि घाव इतने बड़े थे कि उन्हें महीनों तक खुला रखना पड़ता था। टब में बैठकर ड्रेसिंग की जाती थी ताकि संक्रमण न हो और घाव सड़ें नहीं।

लगातार प्लास्टिक सर्जरी से शरीर की त्वचा खत्म हो चुकी थी। डॉक्टर परेशान थे कि अगर एक बार खाल शरीर पर चिपकने में असफल हुईं, तो दूसरी खाल उपलब्ध नहीं थी। हिप वाले हिस्से पर बड़ी खाल लगानी थी, जो कई टुकड़ों में लगाई गई। उस समय वह तीन-चार महीने बिस्तर पर एक इंच भी हिल नहीं सकती थीं। जरा-सी हरकत से त्वचा का चिपकना मृटिकल हो जाता था। एक ही तिरछी करवट में समय बीताना पड़ा। इसी स्थिति में मल-मूत्र, नहाना आदि सब कुछ हुआ।

इंफेक्शन इस कदर था कि एक खत्म होता तो दूसरा शुरू हो जाता। छह महीने से अधिक लगातार तेज़ बुखार रहा, जो किसी एंटीबायोटिक से खत्म नहीं हो रहा था। अस्पताल में हाथ और पैरों पर कैनुला लगा था, और दवाएं इसी से दी जा रही थीं। नवरात्रि के दौरान उन्होंने डॉक्टर से कहा, “आप मुझे दो घंटे के लिए छुट्टी दीजिए, शायद भगवान मुझे बचा सकें।” डॉक्टर आर. एस. मोहिल ने अपने रिस्क पर उन्हें छतरपुर मंदिर भेजा। वहाँ माँ के दर्शन कर, प्रसाद लेकर जब वह अस्पताल लौटीं, तबीयत थोड़ी बिगड़ी लेकिन फिर इंफेक्शन धीरे-धीरे खत्म हो गया।

जो भी नसें उन्हें देखती थीं, उन्हें लगता था कि यह मरीज नहीं बचेगी। लेकिन जब अस्पताल से डिस्चार्ज हुईं, तो नसों की आँखों में आंसू थे। उन्होंने कहा, “यह चमत्कार है। यह ज़रूर किसी विशेष कार्य के लिए बची हैं।”

इसके बाद वह PDUNIPPD में सुबह से शाम तक फिजियोथेरेपी करती रहीं, जो उनके लिए एक मंदिर जैसा स्थान बन गया।

2009 में, एक्सीडेंट के कारण शरीर का कोऑर्डिनेशन खत्म हो गया था। एक बार फिर वह गिरीं, जिससे रीढ़ की हड्डी L2 वर्टेब्रा के तीन टुकड़े हो गए। लापरवाही में समझा गया कि कोई नस दब गई है, लेकिन तीनों टुकड़े अपनी जगह से हट चुके थे। जब उन्होंने खुद पैदल अस्पताल जाकर एक्स-रे करवाया, तो डॉक्टर भी हैरान रह गए कि यह कैसे चल रही हैं, जबकि हड्डियाँ बिखरी हुई हैं।

ऑपरेशन करने से पहले ही डॉक्टर ने कह दिया था कि नीचे का हिस्सा पैरालाइज हो सकता है। इस बार भी भगवान पर भरोसा करके कई महीने तक पूरी तरह बेड रेस्ट करना पड़ा। प्लास्टर नहीं लग सकता था, इसलिए कई महीने एक ही पोजिशन में रहना पड़ा। लैट्रिन, पेशाब, नहाना, सब कुछ उसी स्थिति में हुआ। जब पहली बार उठाया गया तो चक्कर आने लगे और वह बेहोश हो जाती थीं, क्योंकि दिमाग को लेटे रहने की आदत पड़ चुकी थी।

इन शारीरिक कठिनाइयों को तो उन्होंने सह लिया, लेकिन वैवाहिक जीवन की विफलता ने उन्हें भीतर तक तोड़ दिया और आत्महत्या का विचार फिर मन में आया, लेकिन उनके वकील श्री राठी ने उन्हें समझाया कि अब उनका जीवन दूसरों के लिए है।

इस विचार से प्रेरित होकर उन्होंने माँ शक्ति अंतरराष्ट्रीय संस्था की स्थापना की और दिव्यांगजनों, बुजुर्गों और महिलाओं की सेवा में समर्पित हो गईं। वह राष्ट्रीय पैरा ओलंपिक पदक विजेता, राष्ट्रीय पैरा तेराक, दिल्ली राज्य पुरस्कार प्राप्तकर्ता, प्रेरक वक्ता, शिल्पकार और समाजसेवी के रूप में सक्रिय हैं।

2022 में उन्हें ब्रेस्ट कैंसर का पता चला और जीवन बचाने के लिए शारीरिक अंग को निकालना पड़ा। आज भी वह ईश्वर की परीक्षा में निरंतर डटी हुई हैं और यही प्रार्थना करती हैं कि उनका जीवन दूसरों की सेवा में समर्पित रहे।

वर्तमान में वह कई सरकारी पदों पर काम करते हुए सामाजिक न्याय और अधिकारिता मंत्रालय के अंतर्गत आसरा केंद्र का भी संचालन कर रही हैं, जहाँ दिव्यांगों और बुजुर्गों को निशुल्क सहायक उपकरण वितरित किए जाते हैं।

आज क्योंकि कैंसर में दोनों हाथों की एक्सिला भी निकाल दी है और उल्टा हाथ और पैर से दिव्यांगता है, इस परिस्थिति में ब्लड प्रेशर, खून की जांच कभी भी हाथों से नहीं किया जा सकता। पैर में ही canula लगाकर खून की जांच इलाज और ऑपरेशन किया जा सकते हैं। जिंदगी भर किसी भी हाथ से 2 किलो से ज्यादा वजन नहीं उठा सकते क्योंकि lymphadeema बन जाता है, थायराइड ग्लैंड निकलने की वजह से पहले की तरह गाना नहीं गा सकते ज्यादा बोल नहीं सकते, हाथों में कांच की चूड़ियाँ इत्यादि नहीं पहन सकते फिर भी आज योग करके दिव्यांगता से सफलता और कैंसर को मात देकर उनके द्वारा निर्भाई जा रही भूमिकाएँ:

The founder of Mother India Crochet Queen (MICQ) recalls the memory of her grandmother crocheting continuously for hours, and her picking up the craft of crocheting, weaving, embroidery, and designing clothes from her. With her early-learned craft, Subashri set her sights on making the best use of it for doing a world of good.

After bagging four Guinness World Records, MICQ broke another record recently by making 4,517 scarves. This year's record was solely aimed at spreading breast cancer awareness. This decision to devote their time to the breast cancer victims stemmed from her personal loss. Subashri says, "Their lives cannot be extended, at least we can bring a smile on their faces by giving our token of love."

**Crochet for a cause**

In 2015, she decided to make this dream a reality with tangible outcomes. With flyers and Facebook posts, she spread the word to create the world's largest blanket. With soaring responses, the participation snowballed, and each one had different reasons to join the group, but the underlying purpose was self-recognition. Each woman crocheted a strip of blanket, made bundles, and sent it to Chennai, where all were collected. Two days before The Guinness World Record event, all the MICQ members assembled and stitched all the pieces together to form an 11,148 sq m blanket, setting the world record for largest blanket on January 31, 2016.

The story isn't just about personal accomplishments and success, it goes beyond them. They dismantled the blankets and gave them to the needy. The products were also donated through Rotary clubs, NGOs, and social workers.

Most of these people are either abandoned senior citizens, physically disabled, mentally disabled, bedridden and/or people suffering from incurable diseases. All of them had been rescued from the roads where they were found living without a home in miserable conditions.

The abandoned and disabled people are brought to our NGO's centers (Gurukuls) by the Police, Govt. hospitals, referred by hon'ble courts and social welfare departments.

By the grace of God, all the facilities are completely free of charge for less privileged people. Such as accommodation, food, medical care, and other day to day amenities etc.




## ***Introduction to our Gurukuls***

Currently, our daily activities and functions are carried out through two shelters, one located in Bandhwari Village, Gurgaon, Haryana, and the other in Mandawar Village, Haryana. Our Bandhwari Gurukul is situated on the outskirts of Gurgaon, stretching across nearly 2 acres of land, comprising an old age home, medical centre, home for deprived women, and a center for the differently-abled. We have a large community of senior, mentally disabled, and bedridden citizens (between the ages of 18-90 years). Our Mandawar Gurukul home accommodates an even larger community of the underprivileged and will soon become the biggest free of cost shelter home in the world and where 5000 such destitute people can be accommodated for rehabilitation. It is under construction at the moment but is already accommodating more than 650 patients.

The Gurukuls have their own kitchens where 3 meals are cooked daily, a medical center for first aid, medicine and emergency medical requirements, as well as a courtyard for the residents to interact and have Langar under.



Some of the facilities provided free of charge by our NGO's Gurukul (shelter home):


- 1) Around the clock facility of ambulances for transporting our patients/ residents to different hospitals for emergencies and routine checkups.

- 3) In routine we organize extra curriculum activities such as Bhajan sandhyas, kirtans, celebration of different festivals and entertainment for less privileged people to offer joy, happiness and hope.
- 4) Under the supervision of our dedicated team, attendants, volunteers and visiting doctors, we offer around the clock services to hundreds of abandoned and disabled citizens.

Over the years we have rescued thousands of people from the roads, some of whom happen to be retired Judges, Govt. officers, NRI's, Professors, Graduates and abandoned people from well off families but due to circumstances such as old age, incurable disease mental or physical disabilities their own children leave them on the roads or abandon them in hospitals or near stinking garbage yards where they have to eat garbage to survive.



At the time we rescued this poor man, he was suffering from an 8kg hernia. Even though he lived on a street that was always crowded. The whole world walked in front of him but no one stopped to ask him about his deteriorating condition, no one even offered him food. He made extreme progress mentally and in terms of his overall health but after consulting with doctors, it was discovered that if they tried to treat the hernia, there is a 99% possibility that he would not survive the procedure. It is sad to say that even without proceeding with the treatment, he was not able to survive. He passed away in our Ashram in a couple of short weeks after he was rescued from the roads. Jas Kalra then performed Antim Sanskaar for him and took his ashes to Haridvar for Asthi Visarjan. May god give his soul peace.

Out of the total of 4 x 10<sup>12</sup> m<sup>3</sup> of water received as annual rainfall, about 1.05 x 10<sup>12</sup> m<sup>3</sup> is utilized as surface water consisting of 0.7 x 10<sup>12</sup> m<sup>3</sup> from natural water bodies and 0.35 x 10<sup>12</sup> m<sup>3</sup> estimates to be about 1.8 x 10<sup>11</sup> m<sup>3</sup> i.e. approx.. 5% of global water supply (Chitnis, 1981). Most of the rivers (barring a few major rivers) are seasonal and dry up during summers, when the water demand goes maximum and the pollution level becomes acute. Large volume of waste water from industrial activities, containing a variety of objectionable and hazardous constituents such as oils, organic chemicals, heavy metals, pesticides, etc. are releases into the water bodies. This is really a welfare and conservation of resources and the ecological balance. For the human & control of Water Pollution Act in 1974, EPA-Act in 1986 and EPA rules in 1989. The central Pollution Control Board conducted a survey in early eighties and it is reported that the total industrial wastewater generated in the country is about 10% of total domestic effluents generates in all urban settlements (PROBES/11/1982-83). In addition, hazardous semi-solid and solid residues from industry are dumped on the land, which may release pollutants through leaching into surface and ground water. Our water resources are finite and we must preserve them as far as possible. Therefore, the treatment and disposal of industrial as well as domestic wastewater has become an important issue in the present days.

The multiple uses of water in various industrial processes render the wastewater complex in nature and also make its treatment and disposal complicated. Physically, chemically, and biologically, methods are applicable for waste water treatment, but the success and the economy of treatment are not equally good for these three methods.

It is now recognized by most of professionals that the biological method is the most suitable and cheapest for removing organic impurities from the waste stream. The importance of biological treatment is that it is the most energy-efficient method and it conserves natural resources without giving any secondary pollutants. It generates less amount of sludge and the sludge is environment friendly. The operation and maintenance costs are low compared to physical or chemical methods. Therefore, it is gaining importance day by day. The role of microbes in wastewater treatment has wide perspectives. In this report, an effort has been made to review the various schemes of biological wastewater treatment presently existing either as technology or at the R&D stage.

## यूपी पर 150 करोड़ का पर्यावरण हर्जाना

गंगा और उसकी सहायक नदियों में तब सीमा के भीतर शोधन के बगैर सीवेज के प्रवाह रोकने में विफल रहने पर केंद्रीय प्रदूषण नियंत्रण बोर्ड (सीपीसीबी) ने यूपी सरकार पर 150 करोड़ रुपये का पर्यावरण हर्जाना लगाया है। इतना ही नहीं, समय सीमा के भीतर 44 सीवेज शोधन संयंत्र का काम पूरा नहीं किए जाने के बदले में भी सीपीसीबी ने यूपी सरकार पर करीब 26 करोड़ का पर्यावरण हर्जाना लगाया है। इसका खुलासा एनजीटी में पेश ओवरसाइट कमेटी की रिपोर्ट में किया गया है।

एनजीटी प्रमुख न्यायमूर्ति ए.के. गोयल की अग्रवाई वाली पीठ के समक्ष पेश इस रिपोर्ट में कहा गया है कि एनजीटी ने सरकार को गंगा और उसकी सहायक

150 करोड़ रुपये का पर्यावरण हर्जाना लगाया है। साथ ही इस बारे में नोटिस भी जारी किया है।

पूर्व न्यायाधीश न्यायमूर्ति एस.वी.एस. राठी की अग्रवाई में गठित ओवरसाइट कमेटी ने पीठ को बताया कि 44 सीवेज शोधन संयंत्र का काम पूरा नहीं किए जाने पर भी सीपीसीबी ने प्रदेश सरकार पर 26.4 करोड़ का पर्यावरण हर्जाना लगाया है। सरकार ने अभी हर्जाने की रकम जमा नहीं कराई है। हर्जाने की रकम 01 जुलाई 2020 से 31 दिसंबर 2020 तक की है।

कुल 311 नाले हैं जो गंगा और सहायक नदियों में गिरते हैं। पहले चरण में 86 में से 38 ड्रेन अनटेक है वहीं बगैर शोधन के सीवेज का पानी जा रहा है। दूसरे चरण में 215 में से 96 ड्रेन से बगैर शोधन के सीवेज का पानी जा रहा है।



## "Transforming Competitive Exam Preparation with Indian Skills Development Council (Govt. Regd. Orgn): Launch of Online Programs for 170 Government Exams"

An impact assessment study of IIT, New Delhi reports findings from studies on the impact of project 'e-Lakshyavahini' which was a program run by the **CSC academy** in collaboration with **CSC Advisory Board of Haryana** and supported by the **Power Grid Corporation of India Limited**. The 'e-Lakshyavahini' project had supported preparation of competitive exams to 2500 candidates through 50 CSC academy centers in Gurugram district of Haryana state. Under this project the candidates who were preparing for the competitive exams were provided assistance in exam preparation through access to free online content provided through the e-lakshyavahini portal. The participants could access the content at respective CSC academy centres and also through their mobile based applications. The report suggests that such an ecosystem of dedicated manpower and infrastructure for the cause of serving the underprivileged that CSC has should be used at a much larger scale to benefit a larger number of candidates preparing for the competitive exams.

On the basis of the observed impact of the project 'e-Lakshyavahini', this report recommends that more projects on the line of 'e-Lakshyavahini' should be implemented for longer duration and at a larger scale, probably nationwide, to fill the gap in the job preparation ecosystem for resource deprived youth. It was observed in this study that there is a dearth of exam preparation material and coaching centers in rural India. The talented rural youth who do not have access to the exam preparation material and guidance at their remote locations have benefitted from the 'e-Lakshyavahini' program immensely as it provided timely and easy access to exam resources when they needed the most and they did not know where to get it from.


